



Adirondack Miniature Horse Club Show Rules and Regulations 2009

1. <<<<Pre-Entry Special>>>> When you pre-enter by June 22, pay \$10 per horse/handler combination toward paying the pre-entry fees for all the classes in which you would like to show. At the show you pay pre-entry prices for the classes in which you actually show. Exhibitors are responsible for paying for classes after the \$10 is used. The \$10 will be retained as an office fee if you do not come.
2. Classes are open to all horses, miniature horses, and ponies meeting the criteria listed for the class. You do not need to be an affiliated club member to participate. Miniature horses and ponies will be measured for proper class entries unless holding a permanent height card from an appropriate established registry or 2009 NYSSHA measurement card.
3. NYSSHA rules will be observed in all NYSSHA pointed classes. Rule book will be available at entry booth or online at www.nyssha.org. AMHC rules to apply for all other classes and AMHC rules will be available at entry booth or online at www.adkminiclub.com. To be eligible for AMHC Year End Awards you must be a current member of AMHC at the time of the show you wish pointed.
4. The show committee reserves the right to change, move, add, combine, or cancel classes as warranted.
5. All dogs on the show grounds must be leashed at all times. If a dog is found to be unleashed the owner and dog may be asked to leave the show grounds. Dogs should not be near the show ring.
6. Classes must be paid as entered or a blank signed check left with the Secretary.
7. Each horse/handler combination has its own number and separate entry form.
8. Please enter at least 2 classes in advance. You must scratch 2 classes in advance or be charged for the class. \$2 is added to each class if you are not pre-entered.
9. Pleasure driving and country pleasure driving classes may not be cross-entered. Ground driving obstacle and any driving class may not be cross-entered.
10. Liberty class entrants must provide music on either CD or tape, cued to correct music if necessary.
11. The Miniature and Pony For Sale Class is not a judged class but a showcase for entrants. Provide a written description of each horse and/or pony to be read by the announcer. Pay only grounds fees and \$2 per entry.
12. All classes marked with * are not NYSSHA pointed. All classes marked with + are not AMHC pointed. All classes marked with # are Championship classes and there is no fee. Ribbons will be awarded through sixth place.
13. Each horse must have proof of rabies vaccination and a current (2008, 2009) negative Coggins test. Please be sure that copies are legible.
